

REQUEST FOR EXCUSED ABSENCES DURING EDUCATIONAL TIME

Because of the Salt Lake City School District's commitment to quality education, we are concerned when a child misses school for any reason. Utah Compulsory Attendance Laws (Code 53A-11-101-105) require that every school age child be enrolled in school and attend regularly. Students may be excused from school attendance for valid and legitimate reasons: illness, medical appointments, family emergencies, death of family member or close friend, and observance of religious holidays. Family activity or travel requires prior approval of school principal.

Please note that even though a student has an opportunity to make up work, extended absences may negatively impact the student's academic progress. While some assignments may be made up, some class experiences cannot be replicated and a student's progress may suffer.
